Project Monitoring:

ICC undertakes project monitoring both for plant owners (as Owner's Engineer) or for funding organisations that wish to ensure that funding money is used effectively and according to contracts.

To perform this duty ICC offers the following services;

- Ensure that all necessary insurances and health and safety systems are in place at the start of the project
- Ensure all the required government and local authority regulations have been met and are in place
- Ensure all stakeholders are kept informed and establish a project steering committee
- Review design drawings and calculations
- Monitor project time-scales to ensure that activities take place according to the project plan, highlighting any significant issues and develop a project risk register
- Monitor that adequate resources are provided and planned for
- Attend monthly project progress meetings and produce a monthly report of project progress whilst also monitoring the project spend against budget
- Support the signing off and release of funds at each stage to ensure that all work is completed according to the contract and witness plant performance tests

Services and Requirements:

The requirement for external project monitoring will depend on many factors including the Owner's (Single or multiple partners) capability, the equipment suppliers, the contractor(s) and type of contract (Total Turnkey versus Package Turnkey). Financial institutions may require bespoke approaches and analysis.
